



- What moves to PRC and what's lost?
 - Move daily senior citizen lunch nutrition program
 - Move Wednesday Moraine Senior Citizens Club
 - Room rentals can still rent at the PRC
 - Special events and classes can be held at the PRC
 - Would lose the weekday afterschool tutoring program (Moraine Meadows children)
 - Would lose the neighborhood kids daily opportunity to use GCC game room unless a shuttle transported them to the PRC

- One Bulk Trash pickup, instead of two
- Raise all fines

Putting the pieces in the puzzle

2010 Cost Summary

- Waste Collection: \$300,000
- Montgomery Fee (formerly Incinerator Fee): \$50,000
- Bulk Trash Pick Up: \$52,081
- **Street Lighting:** \$250,158
- Parks & Rec w/Splash Levy: \$1,600,000
- Safety Services Levy: \$900,000
- **Cemetery Care & Maintenance:** \$15,000
- Rec Activities (Fourth of July, Halloween, Christmas, etc): \$25,000
- DARE: \$32,000 grant covers cost
- Seniors Snow Removal: \$775 (for 70-80 driveways)

Committee Goal(s)

- Provide Council direction regarding the priorities of the Citizens
 - What steps do we follow?
 - Reductions in operations
 - Increase Fees
 - Elimination of Programs
 - Additional activity specific options (levy, charges, etc...)
 - Combination of all
