We realize that many people do not have their animals spayed or neutered due to lack of knowledge or the perceived high cost. Our goal is to provide education and low-cost spay and neuter services to families in need.

Spaying or neutering your dog or cat is a healthy decision for you and your pet. In addition to reducing or preventing some medical problems in animals, such as tumors of the reproductive organs, uterine infections or sexually transmitted diseases, spaying or neutering may help decrease aggression. Spaying will also eliminate unwanted pregnancies in your animals.

Pre-Surgical Instructions

- Do not allow your pet to eat or drink after 10:00 p.m. the night before its scheduled surgery.
- Bring your pet to the Humane Society between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. the morning of surgery. Enter through the rear door, marked "Surgery Entrance." <u>Cats must be in carries and dogs must be on leashes!</u>
- Pick up your pet between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on weekdays and between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays.
